Summerset has made the decision to move the company's Annual Meeting of Shareholders to an online event only.

Wellington, where the meeting was to take place, has had a state of emergency announced this afternoon, following extreme rainfall and flash flooding. With a red rain warning now in place, and the threat of more to come, the company does not feel it was prudent or responsible to hold an in-person event.
