Accordant Group Limited (AGL) advises that Jason Cherrington has notified the Board of his intention to retire from his CEO role towards the end of the FY27 financial year enabling a focus on his non-executive director portfolio.

Accordant Chair Simon Bennett said the Board was grateful for Jason's leadership and significant contribution to the Group during a period of unprecedented change. "On behalf of the Board, our people and shareholders, I thank Jason for his commitment, leadership and stewardship of the Group over the last 5 years. We have commenced a search for Jason's replacement and are confident we have the time to ensure an orderly transition."

Since joining in 2021, Jason has successfully led the Group through the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, a prolonged economic downturn and significant changes across New Zealand's labour market. Under his leadership, the Group progressed its diversification strategy, completed the integration of Hobson Leavy, strengthened operational efficiency and completed a successful capital raise. This has positioned Accordant well for the future as the business returns to growth.
